Q. Kenny, 6 over. Talk me through the course today.

Q. You said about experience. How are you looking forward to Round 2?

KENNY LESEUR: I think it's really close to being around 71, 72 tomorrow, just got to make a couple more putts. You know, have the chances and giving myself more opportunities around the course.

Q. Obviously there's been a lot of folks (inaudible), names we're looking out for. How has that been around the course and the buildup to the event?

KENNY LESEUR: What's that again?

Q. You're one of the names that people have been looking out for, 15-year-old qualifier. How has that been for you dealing with the pressure in the buildup?
