PGA TOUR APP

Experience the PGA TOUR like never before on your iOS or Android device with the official PGA TOUR App. Follow all of the action from a single app, available for free from the App Store or Google Play. Get live scoring, course map, and more.

MOBILE DEVICE POLICY

Spectators are allowed to take photos with their mobile devices throughout the golf course, except in areas of competition during official rounds or when requested by players, security, and TOUR officials to refrain from taking a photo. Receiving or placing phone calls will remain limited to areas outside of play.

- **Devices must be on silent at all times;** flash may not be used.
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g., personal social media); no commercial use.
- No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage).
- Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Phone calls are allowed in areas away from play.
- Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media.
- All posted signage and instructions from tournament staff must be observed.
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in the revocation of your ticket.

CAMERA POLICY

No point and shoot, film or DSLR cameras permitted on-site.

PARKING INFORMATION

All public parking will be free of charge.

ARRIVING VIA CAR

Public Car/Electric Car Parking: White Hill Field (off Middle Road)

Spectators planning on driving are encouraged to carpool. Complimentary shuttles will run continuously to and from Port Royal Golf Course all four days of the Bermuda Championship. Shuttles will begin 15 minutes before gates open.

ARRIVING VIA MOTOR BIKE

Public Bike Parking:

Spectators planning on taking a motor bike have two options for parking:

1. Death Valley Playing Field at the Main Spectator Entrance
2. White Hill Field

TAXI DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

Taxis will be directed to drop-off and pick-up near the clubhouse.

ARRIVING VIA PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Public Bus System: Spectators planning on taking a pink government bus from any other location other than the public parking lots are encouraged to take Routes 7 and 8 that run from Hamilton and Dockyard. This bus will drop off and pick up at the Main Entrance to the Bermuda Championship.

Concession stands are located near hole 6, hole 16 and hole 18 and serve a variety of food and beverage products.

BAG POLICY

Certain items are restricted at PGA TOUR events. Bags will be searched upon entering the event.

- Bags and purses must be smaller than 6" x 6".
- Clear bags measuring 12" x 6" x 12" or less will be permitted.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY
 Spectators will be alerted to weather that officials for the tournament identify as potentially dangerous. Weather warnings will be broadcast on the electronic leader boards that are located throughout the golf course. Spectators should take appropriate precautions upon observing any weather warnings.

A prolonged blast on an air horn, repeated once, will indicate that tournament play has been suspended, and all attendees should seek safe shelter immediately. Two short blasts of an air horn, repeated once will indicate play has resumed.

Avoid the following: Hilltops/high places; golf carts; isolated trees; wire fences
